

Based in New York City, the "breathtaking" and "paradigm-shifting" (New York Music Daily) string quartet, The Overlook, is dedicated to a more representative and relevant musical practice. The quartet has been presented in performances and residencies highlighting the work of living composers around the country with recent highlights including collaborating with NY Philharmonic clarinetist Anthony McGill, presenting an immersive experience performing in the life size sculptures of Linda Sormin at MassMOCA, and sharing the stage with jazz legend Joe Lovano in a piece for string quartet and improvising musician.

The quartet formed from a simple need to make and share music with others during the pandemic shutdown.
